Health Promotion

This program reduces risk factors in adults for heart disease, stroke, cancer and injuries. We provide screening for the early detection of heart disease and stroke, and education, referral and follow-up for pre-disease or disease conditions. Cholesterol screenings are provided for persons 20 years and over and children with risk factors with a physician's order.

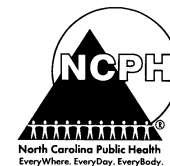

Adult Primary Care

The Adult Nurse Practitioner offers health screenings to clients 18 years and older. Annual physical examinations and acute care are provided. Some conditions may require a physician's consultation and/or referral.

Diabetes Control Education Classes

A registered Nurse and Dietician teach clients how to best control diabetes. The class focuses on leading healthy lifestyles like eating smart and moving more. Clients will also learn about checking their blood sugar and taking their medication. Health Education staff members also offers Diabetes and Chronic Disease Self-Management classes to interested clients (minimum of 7 participants per class).



Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP)

BCCCP provides breast and cervical cancer screening and follow-up services. Women who are age 50 or older are eligible to receive breast and follow-up services. Women less than 40 years of age are eligible for clinical breast exams. Instruction in breast self exam and follow-up services are also provided. This program provides services for:

- Underinsured or uninsured
- Ethnic/Minorities
- Women who are never or rarely screened
- Eligible women ages 18-64

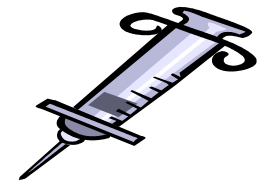
(Women who receive Medicaid, Medicare, or Family Planning Services are not eligible for BCCCP.)



Adult Immunizations

We provide immunizations for the following:

- Adult boosters
- Immunizations for travel
- Immunizations for exposure to communicable disease
- Influenza
- Pneumonia



Screenings

We screen clients for early detection of the following:

Diabetes—at risk clients are screened for early detection of diabetes

Hypertension—detects high blood pressure

Cholesterol—detects high total cholesterol

We provide referral, monitoring, and follow-up according to clinic guidelines.
